## Deb's Top 10 Grant Tips

- 1. Be prepared to apply more than once before you are successful.
- 2. Subscribe to the Community Broadcasting Foundation Newsletter at <a href="http://www.cbf.com.au/cbf-update/subscribe-cbf-update/">http://www.cbf.com.au/cbf-update/subscribe-cbf-update/</a>
- 3. Check the CBF website to see what's available and when the applications open and close for particular grants.

- 4. Read the guidelines carefully to make sure your project fits within the guidelines.
- 5. Contact the Grants Officer at BayFM by email <a href="mailto:grants@bayfm.org">grants@bayfm.org</a> The project may not fit into CBF guidelines but there may be other avenues for funding the grants officer is aware of.
- 6. Be prepared to write an application on your project. This takes a lot of time and continuous editing.
- 7. Budget is very important so get quotes and be able to justify expenditure and work on \$25/hr for production.
- 8. Grants have to be acquitted that means everything has to be accounted for. Keep receipts. And keep notes on what worked and what did not for your final report.
- 9. The Grants Officer is available to help.
- 10. Do not leave it until the last minute.
