USB Feed from Laptop to Desk

In Studio 2 we have installed a USB device that works like a soundcard and will enable using the desk directly from your laptop through this cable, so no extra cable requires to go out of the headphone socket of the laptop to PC left or PC right input.

Here are the instructions:

It is important to note that anyone wanting to use it should try it out and test it before going to air the first time!

*The **USB cable**, with corresponding **USB channel** on the left side of the desk, is a “driverless” **sound card**. It will put any audio from your laptop to air.*

*Just plug the USB cable into your laptop (PC or Mac) and select the USB device on your machine. Your laptop sound device selector or audio program settings should give you the option to select the USB for your sound output. It will say something like “**USB Audio Codec**” (might differ between different brands of laptops).*

*Make sure the **volume on your laptop is on full 100%**. Sound will not come from your laptop but rather through the Studio desk.*

*The USB fader on the desk (3rd from left on the desk) is your input. This is where you control the level. Note that both “**PGM**” and “**LINE**” at the top of the module have to be **selected** (2 lights on).*
